POSITION TITLE: Call to Action Team Leader

HOURS: Full Time

PREPARATION: Bachelor's degree in human services or education with positive youth development and engaging men and boys experience desirable. Experience in program development, community engagement, training/facilitation, educational groups, and knowledge of school-based athletics programs is desirable. Knowledge of community resources and intimate partner violence prevention is desirable. Bi-cultural and bi-lingual Spanish is desirable (not required). Must be sensitive to issues of diversity.

SUPERVISOR: Prevention and Outreach Coordinator

JOB SUMMARY: Responsible for the development and implementation of the Ottawa County Call to Action Project to engage men and boys in prevention programming. Implement the Coaching Boys into Men (CBIM) Program by training school athletics coaches to administer the CBIM program to high school boys during a 12-week season to strengthen bystander skills and promote non-violence. Recruit for and lead the Call to Action Team (CAT), an action-oriented men's leadership group working to prevent domestic and sexual violence, and work collaboratively with schools and partner agencies to develop culturally relevant prevention strategies. Work with the CAT to develop an educational Call to Action tool and plan a community-wide Call to Action event for men and boys in the community.
